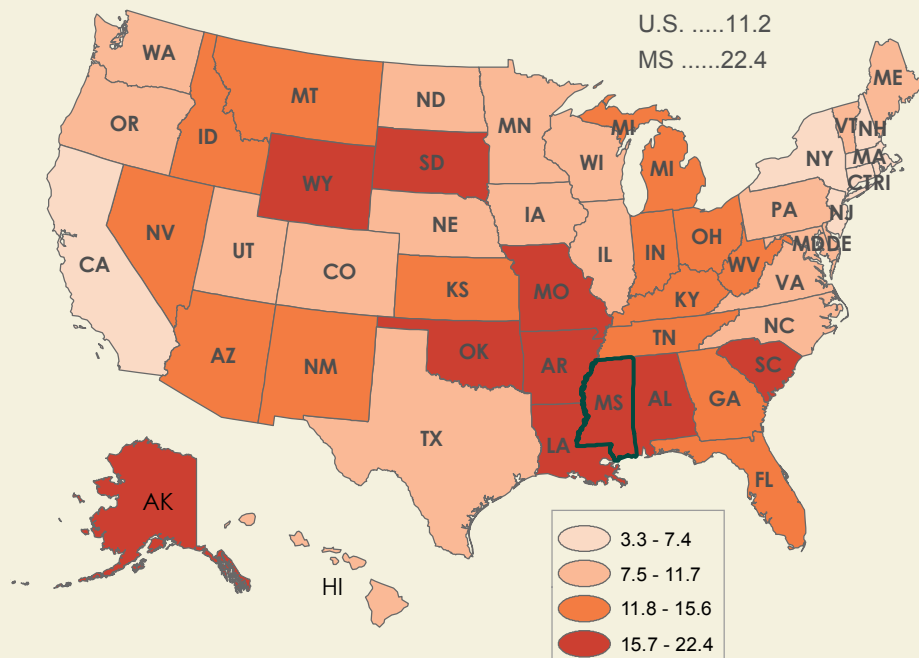


# National Child Mortality Rate (age 0-9), 2005-2014

(due to external causes)

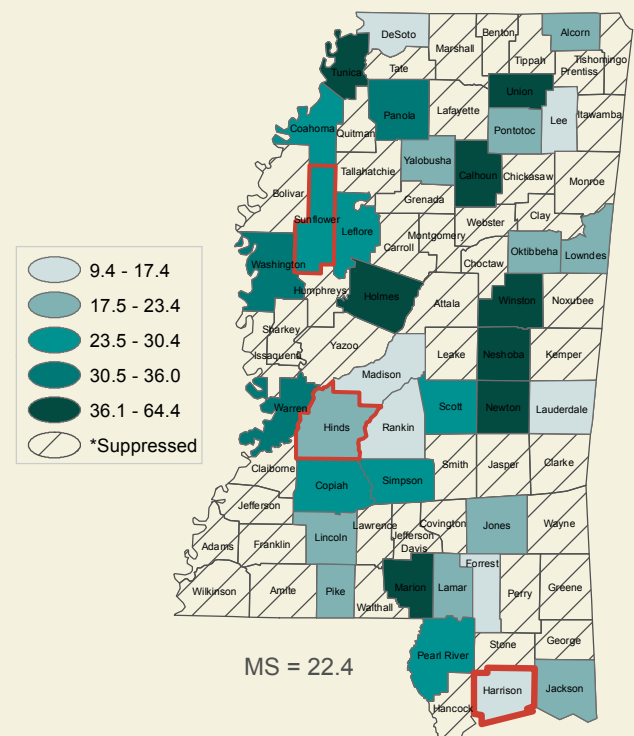


Mississippi is the only state with a rate more than 22 in the nation.
