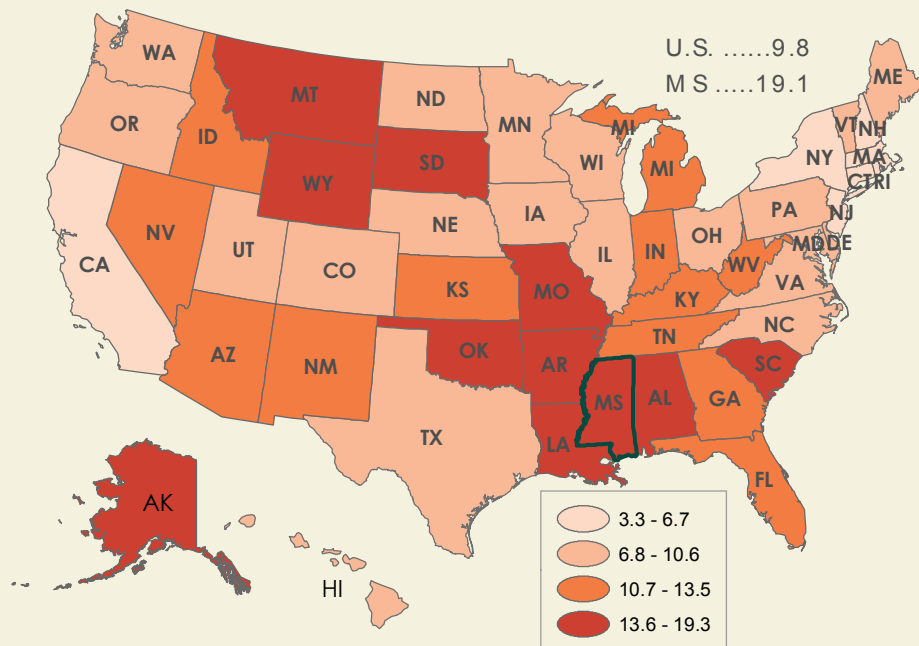


National Child Mortality Rate (age 0-14), 2005-2014

(due to external causes)

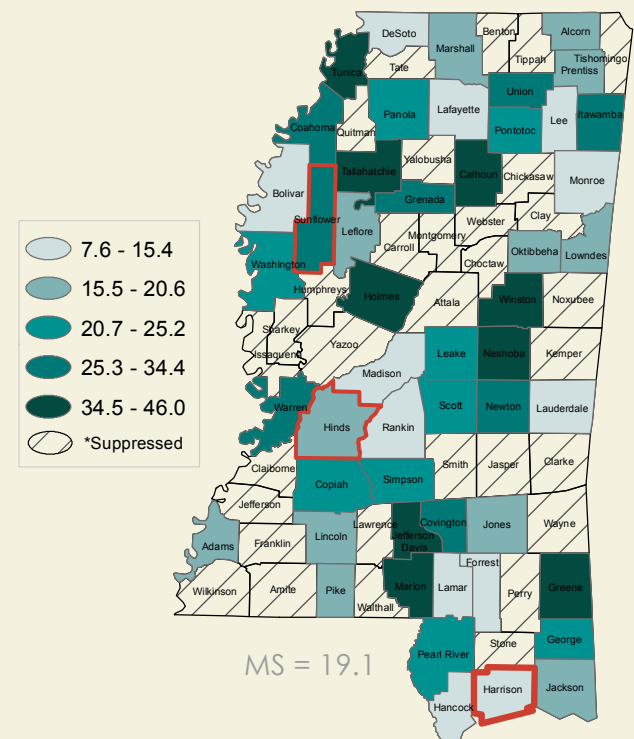


Mississippi and Alaska are the highest in the nation with a rate over 19.
